



I. REGISTRY

1. Log in to the website *Ingeniería y Universidad: Engineering for Development Journal* (<https://revistas.javeriana.edu.co/index.php/iyu>). And *Register*.




2. Send an e-mail requesting registration indicating the following data:


II. SUBMISSION

1. Log in to the website *Ingeniería y Universidad: Engineering for Development Journal* (<https://revistas.javeriana.edu.co/index.php/iyu>). And *Login* with your username and password.

Click on the button “*New Submission*”.



2. The submission consists of 5 steps:
 - a. **First:** Select the language of your paper, either English or Spanish. Remember that the article will be **published only in English**; therefore, when the article is approved, the authors must carry out a professional revision of the English language at their own expense, providing a certificate of translation or proofreading of the English language.

They must also select the area of engineering they belong to or the special issue they wish to participate in. Then accept the requirements and policies of the journal, and finally click on the following button “*Save and continue*”

- The manuscript sent is in a format .doc or .docx
- The ORCID of the authors is included (if you don't have it you must register in the platform ORCID). We also suggest to update the authors profiles in Google Scholar and Colciencias (CvLAC).






The **abstract**, as well as the title, should be in English and Spanish. Additionally, it should be structured and should not exceed 200 words.

The abstract or summary should be structured. It consists of a paragraph formed by a set of sentences or short sentences that describe the most relevant of each part of the manuscript, the following sections: Objective; Methods and materials; Results and discussion; Conclusions and Keywords.

Example:

Objective: This research aims to observe the extent to which several surface treatment techniques increase the surface roughness of titanium alloy implants which was manufactured via electrical discharge machining (EDM). The effects of these techniques were also observed to decrease the Cu content on the implant surface. **Materials and Methods:** In this research, ultrasonic cleaning, rotary tumbler polishing, and brushing were employed as techniques to increase the roughness of a titanium implant which was manufactured via EDM, to the moderately rough category, and to reduce the contaminant element deposited on its surface. An MTT (3-(4,5-dimethylthiazol-2-yl)-2,5-diphenyltetrazolium bromide) assay test was also used to observe the effect of these engineered specimens with respect to mesenchymal stem cells' proliferation. **Results and Discussion:** The results show that ultrasonic cleaning and rotary tumbler polishing created a significant increase (90% and 67%, respectively) in the surface roughness. On the other hand, brushing was shown to be the best benchmark for reducing the contamination of Copper (Cu). Furthermore, rotary tumbler polishing and brushing can increase the percentage of living cells compared to the original surface EDM specimens. **Conclusion:** All micro-finishing methods that were employed are able to increase the surface roughness of Ti alloy based-implant to a moderately rough category.

The paper is in the Editorial Review stage, which consists of a formal review of the minimum requirements for submission. Remember that you can consult them in the author's guide.






